Separate entries must be made to shows and fairs.**

4-H members are responsible for the accuracy of all information provided. The 4-H county staff signature is verification of date of submission only. **REMINDER:** All mammals except rabbits and cavyies must have been vaccinated for rabies 30 days prior to first event or show. Unvaccinated rabbits and cavyies must be housed in a way that protects them from exposure to wildlife.

4-H Online Intent to Show (Animal registration) may be completed instead of this form.

MEMBER INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING 4-H ANIMAL FORM

On your Intent to Show Form, list all 4-H project animals you might show **unless the animal is registered in the member's name in which case registration papers are acceptable**. (Hint: It is best to include all eligible project animals; your favorite might not be feeling well on show day.) **Print In Blue or Black Pen or Type**. Complete the form including your mailing address with zip code, email, and age as of 1/1 of the current year. List one animal per line and one species per form. Do not skip any lines. Print clearly. **Remember, All Animals In A 4-H Project Must Be Solely Owned Or Borrowed (Leased) By The 4-H Member**. (The farm name cannot be used for owner of animals).

Deadlines for submitting Intent to Show Forms to your 4-H County Extension office for signature:

February 1: Beef steers that will show at the Eastern State Exposition 4-H Beef Show.

May 1: Beef Heifers that will show at ESE, (excluding ESE steers), Working Steers, Dogs, Dairy Cattle, Llamas eligible for ESE.

All 4-H project animals must be at least four months by show day to be shown or exhibited at a 4-H event. For instance, a lamb born on April 30 could not be exhibited or brought to a 4-H event before August 30. . Exceptions may be made by individual events for unweaned animals if housed with the mother as an exhibit.

1. **Animal name:** List the animal's name. If registrations are pending, include the registration numbers of the animal's sire and dam in this space. When you get the registration number call your 4-H Extension office to update your form (you may want to use a separate form for animals with pending registrations).
 2. **I.D. number, tattoo, or farm tag:** All animals shown and exhibited must have a permanent form of identification. A legible tattoo for a breed association, scrapie tag, or tamper proof metal tag. Poultry must have a pullorum leg tag if over five months of age. **Market lambs must be slick shorn to be shown in all market lamb classes.**
 3. **Date of Birth:** Enter the *animal's* date of birth.
 4. **Sex/Breed:** Enter the sex and breed (or crossbreed) of the animal.
 5. **Registration Number:** Indicate registration number of all registered animals here.
 6. **Owned or Borrowed** - Indicate Owned (O) or Borrowed (B) in this space. Registration papers or borrowing agreement **MUST** be in the exhibitor's name. If leasing, please refer to fact sheet "Suggestions for 4-H Animal Borrowing".
 7. **Date Acquired** -. List the date the animal was acquired via ownership or borrowing.
 8. Submit this form to your 4-H Extension office prior to the proper date (see above) or complete the 4-H Online animal registration by the deadline. The 4-H county staff will sign, date, and validate your form prior to returning it to you.
 9. Forms not filled out properly will be returned. **It is the member's responsibility to correct the form and return it to the 4-H office by the deadline.**
 10. Replacement animal rules are determined by individual shows and fairs. Please check with the show superintendent if you have questions regarding replacement animals.
- ★ If you did not enroll in the 4-H program through 4-H Online, you are required to attach a Youth Medical Care and Treatment form and the Youth Code of Conduct/Permission Release form to your animal intent to show form.
