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Forest Market Report 1951

INTRODUCTION

Woodland owners and operators are anxious to know about the forest market outlook for the cutting season 1950-51. The Korean situation, coupled with a building boom, have placed stumpage owners in a definitely favorable position. Not only is there an active demand for stumpage and logs for lumber, but the demand for pulpwood is also especially active. Pulpwood buyers during the fall of 1950 are encouraging woodland owners to cut as much pulpwood as possible. This active demand for forest products is causing an increase in the prices paid for stumpage, logs, and pulpwood. While stumpage prices have increased, the advance is not equivalent to the advance in the price for lumber and other forest products that are processed or partially processed. The woodland owner is obliged to pay more for woods' labor than he did last winter.

Woodland owners, especially farmers who are in the position to do so, should get out their own logs, pulpwood, or other forest products and sell them at the roadside, on the car, or at the mill. In this way it is possible to take full advantage of the prices paid for logs, pulpwood, and other forest products at the roadside or delivered at the mill.

PREDICTIONS OF MARKET TRENDS

Any prediction of market trends during the next few months must be qualified to allow for unforeseen trends in the existing economic situation. At present, it looks as if an active demand for stumpage, used for lumber and pulpwood, will continue during the fall and winter season. At the same time, we should recognize that government curbs that are being placed on civilian production and consumption will retard the building boom and other industries where forest products are used. Off-setting this situation, there will be increasing demands for forest products to meet the needs of the expanding defense program.

Leading economists state that over the long period (approximately 60 years) the value of stumpage will be gradually upward, recognizing, of course, the minor fluctuations in prices that are affected by business trends.

Every woodland owner should understand this trend in prices and should hold onto immature stumpage. Good trees should be kept growing when they are laying on the maximum amount of wood each year and thereby are earning the owner the most money. For example, 12-inch white pine should saw out about 90 board feet. The tree is worth 90 cents, based upon a \$10 per M stumpage value. If the 12-inch pine is allowed to stand until it is 18 inches in diameter, it should be possible to saw out 250 board feet and the stumpage value of the tree, based upon a \$15 per M stumpage, would be worth \$3.75. Under average growing conditions it should take a

12-inch pine tree 20 years to reach 18 inches in diameter; consequently one 12-inch white pine tree, left to grow for 20 years until it reaches 18 inches in diameter, is earning the owner \$.14 each year. It is easy to calculate how much a large number of 12-inch pine which are growing in a properly managed woodlot will earn the owner over a period of 20 years.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SELLING

Woodland owners often do not appreciate the accummulating value of a growing tree. They frequently sell stumpage at a time when the trees are growing the fastest with the result that the stumpage may be sold at a figure below its actual value.

Every New Hampshire woodland owner who plans to sell stumpage is urged to consider the following recommendations before selling it.

- 1. Find out from sawmills and wood-using industries what prices they offer for various wood products in order that you may take advantage of the best market. Compare the local prices with those quoted from other sections of the State.
- 2. Before selling, consult your neighbors who have recently disposed of their timber and use their experience as a guide. Ask your County Forester. In many instances, failure to do this has resulted in the woodland owner not getting full value of the product.
- 3. Thoroughly investigate all local timber requirements and prices, since, in many cases, local markets pay better prices than outside markets because of the saving of transportation charges.
- 4. Advertise, and secure competition among outside purchasers. The expense will be small and outside buyers will thus learn of chances to bid on timber in competition with local buyers.
- 5. Secure bids whenever practical, both by the lump and by log scale measure. A choice is thus offered, and a more profitable form of bid can be accepted.
- 6. Consider the responsibility of the prospective purchaser before making the sale in order to avoid slow payment, costly collections, and losses.
- 7. When there is quality timber to market, these trees are worth more than the average or poor quality tree. Be sure the buyer takes the factor of tree quality into consideration when offering you a price for stumpage.
- 8. Remember that standing timber does not deteriorate rapidly. The owner, therefore, may not be obliged to place his product on the market, if the price offered is not satisfactory. Use a written timber sale agreement, particularly where the cutting is done by the purchaser. Sell only trees that should be cut. These trees should be marked by the owner or his agent with the help and advice of a qualified forester. Reliable operators will make partial cutting by taking only the marked trees if the owner insists.

ASSISTANCE RENDERED BY THE COUNTY FORESTER

Before making a timber sale get in touch with your county forester. He can supply you with a sample contract form. Your county forester will assist a woodland owner in the examination of his woodlands and make

recommendations for managing them. He will help the woodland owner or his agent in marking trees for cutting. He will explain to woodland owners the new 10 per cent yield tax on wood and timber when it is cut, and how to earn the 30 per cent tax abatement for practicing good forestry. The tax abatement is a reward to the owner (person who has the responsibility of cutting the trees) for meeting the two major objectives of partial cutting. (1) Preserve the rapidly-growing immature trees which will be more profitable to cut after a future growing period; (2) provide for the reseeding of desirable species.

Owner Operation of Woodlands

Woodland owners, especially farmers who have merchantable timber ready for market, should consider harvesting it themselves, especially when they have the labor and the team or tractor with which to do the job. The woodland owner who can get out his own logs or pulpwood can realize both the stumpage value and the price that would be paid for woods' labor.

Range of Prices Paid for Forest Products, October 1950

It's very difficult to list a range of prices paid for forest products. Quality, quantity, location, logging chance, demand, and other factors affect the price paid. The range in prices paid for hardwood stumpage, roadside, and mill deliveries is so varied that the prices quoted show an extremely wide range. The quality of hardwood varies greatly from generally poor quality in southern New Hampshire to a variation of poor and good quality in northern New Hampshire. Veneer-grade logs bring an excellent price delivered at veneer mills.

[†]A fair method of determining stumpage values for a tract of timber is to compute the total cost of the operation (cutting-yarding) and about 20 per cent for profit and risk, and deduct the whole from the going roadside prices.
