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The Forest Market Situation *

Lumber

National lumber consumption during 1954 is estimated at 40.5 billion board feet or about the same as consumption in 1952 and 1953. In 1955 lumber consumption is expected to remain at about this level, primarily because no major changes are expected in construction and industrial activity during that year. Thus, lumber production from domestic forests is expected to amount to about 39 billion board feet. The West is expected to account for about half of the lumber produced domestically, the South 35 percent, and the North 15 percent.

Lumber and stumpage prices have declined slightly in the last three years and in August, 1954, lumber prices were about 4 percent below the all-time peak reached in 1951. No significant change in prices is anticipated during 1955. At the start of 1955 the demand for pine stumpage in New Hampshire was active as compared with the fall season of 1954.

Pulpwood

Pulpwood consumption in 1954 is estimated at 28 million cords -- about 2.7 percent higher than the previous peak year in 1953 and about 76 percent higher than consumption at the end of World War II. This does not include the equivalent of an estimated 10 million cords of pulpwood that will be imported in the form of wood pulp and paper and board. Some further increase in domestic pulpwood consumption is expected in 1955 in response to anticipated increases in population, pulp production, and the development of new uses for paper and pulp products. In addition, there will be considerable pressure to operate new plant facilities that are expected to increase the capacity of the wood pulp industry to about 22 million tons in 1955. This will represent an increase of about 1 million tons over the capacity in 1954.

Production from domestic forests in 1955 is expected to be above the estimated 27 million cords produced in 1954. In 1955 the South is expected to account for about 60 percent of the total production, the North 20 percent, and the West the remaining 20 percent. Pine and other preferred softwood such as spruce and fir are expected to account for about 85 percent of the total pulpwood production.

The new peak in pulpwood consumption achieved in 1954 marks a continuation of a period of extremely rapid growth in the pulp and paper industry. Since 1946 the capacity of the United States wood pulp industry has increased from 12.1 million tons to about 21 million tons -- or a rise of about 75 percent.

Although the pulp mills in the Northeast consumed less wood during the first three quarters of 1954 than during the corresponding period of 1953, wood inventories at the end of September 1954 were 275,000 cords less than at the end of September, 1953.

Forecasts of an increase in paper and paperboard production and the output of wood pulp combined with relatively low pulpwood inventories point toward satisfactory activity in the pulpwood market during the coming months. As in the past, it will be advisable for farmers and other owners of small and medium sized forest properties to withhold log and pulpwood production until they know they can get a sale at a satisfactory price.

Veneer Logs and Bolts

The national production of veneer logs during 1954, estimated at 2.6 billion board feet, is somewhat higher than prior years largely because of a trend toward increased use of softwood plywood in construction. This trend is expected to continue and production and prices of these relatively high value products are expected to increase slightly in 1955.

Other Timber Products

In 1955 the consumption of all other forest products such as poles, piling, posts, and other miscellaneous products is expected to remain near the levels of consumption in 1954. Local demands for forest products for special uses can affect local requirements for such products.

The Forest Resources of New Hampshire *

When consideration is given to the market for forest products, it is important to have an understanding of the Forest Resources of New Hampshire. These are the facts in brief.

Forest Economy

New Hampshire is one of the most extensively forested states; 84 percent of its land area is covered with forest. Its economy depends heavily on these forests. One out of every five workers in the State depends on the forests, either directly or indirectly, for his livelihood.

The Forest Industries

Some 700 forest enterprises operate in New Hampshire. They put intense pressure on the forest resource. The pulp and paper mills have to import large quantities of pulpwood and wood pulp. Lumber and veneer are imported. Some industries have trouble finding the kinds of raw material they need.

Forest Ownership

Private owners hold most of the forest land in New Hampshire - 85 percent of it. Most of the forest properties are small. The pattern of private ownership and small holdings create special problems in improving management and in utilizing the forest resource efficiently.

Timber Volume

New Hampshire's commercial forests contain 10 billion board feet of timber. A third of the volume is white pine.

Condition of the Forests

The forests of New Hampshire have survived 300 years of hard usage, but now small trees predominate; and, for the State as a whole, the volume of growing stock is only fair. There is a large volume of hardwood cull.

Growth and Annual Cut

Net growth exceeds timber cut, but this is nothing to be complacent about because the land is actually growing trees at a rate far below capacity. Softwood sawtimber is being cut faster than it grows. Most of the excess growth is in small hardwood trees.

An Opportunity

Where growth exceeds timber cut, as it does in New Hampshire, there is an excellent opportunity to rebuild the forest resource. Increasing use of hardwoods by industry brightens the prospects for balancing the timber budget. Improving the management and utilization of New Hampshire forests is recommended.

Recommendations for Selling

New Hampshire woodland owners who plan to sell stumpage, logs, pulpwood, and other forest products are urged to consider the following recommendations before selling:

1. Find out from buyers of stumpage, logs, pulpwood, and other forest products, the prices they offer in order that you may take advantage of the best market. Compare the local prices with those quoted from other sections of the State.
2. Before selling, consult your neighbors who have recently disposed of their timber and use their experience as a guide. Ask your County Forester. In many instances, failure to do this has resulted in the woodland owner not getting full value of the product.
3. Thoroughly investigate all local timber requirements and prices, since, in many cases, local markets pay better prices than outside markets because of the saving of transportation charges.
4. Advertise and secure competition among outside purchasers. The expense will be small and outside buyers will thus learn of chances to bid on timber in competition with local buyers.
5. Secure bids whenever possible, both by the lump and by log scale measure. A choice is thus offered, and a more profitable form of bid can be accepted.
6. Consider the responsibility of the prospective purchaser before making the sale in order to avoid slow payment, costly collections, and losses.

7. When there is quality timber to market, these trees are worth more than the average or poor-quality tree. Be sure the buyer takes the factor of tree quality into consideration when offering you a price for stumpage.

8. Remember that standing timber usually increases in value. The owner, therefore, is not obliged to place his product on the market, if the price offered is not satisfactory. Sell only trees that should be cut. These trees should be marked by the owner or his agent with the help and advice of a qualified forester. Reliable operators will make partial cutting by taking only the marked trees, if the owner insists.

9. A written timber sale agreement between buyer and seller is important before cutting starts on a lot. Sample sale agreement forms to fit different kinds of operations can be obtained from your County Forester.

Assistance Rendered by the County Forester

The County Forester helps woodland owners to help themselves. Your County Forester will assist you in the examination of your woodlands and make recommendations for managing them. He will help you or your agent in marking trees for cutting, and advise you in the marketing of forest products.

There are thousands of acres of young growing trees, such as pine, spruce, fir and desirable hardwood, that can be converted into desirable stands of trees, if the overtopping weed trees are cut or killed. It is profitable to prune young, fast-growing, well-formed white pine with the purpose of growing quality logs that will yield clear lumber. Your County Forester can assist you in getting a forest improvement program started in the young stands on your woodlands.

Range of Prices Paid for Forest Products, January 1955

Quality, quantity, location, logging chance, demand, and other factors affect the prices paid for stumpage, logs, pulpwood, piling, poles, fuelwood, and other forest products. The range in prices paid for hardwood stumpage and for roadside and mill deliveries is so varied that the prices quoted show an extremely wide range. The quality of hardwood varies greatly from generally poor quality in southern New Hampshire to a variation of poor and good quality in Northern New Hampshire.

Lengths: 25' 30' 35' 40' 45' 50' 55' 60' 65' 70' & 75' long

Tops: Not less than 6" diameter and not more than 10" diameter under bark.

Butts: Not less than 8" diameter and not more than 20" diameter under bark. Material must be free from short crooks, excessive sweeps and rot. No light between string line laid from center of top to center of butt. Knots to be trimmed close to the body of the stick. Material need not be put on skids or brow.
