

#### FOREST MARKET REFORT

1956

## The Forest Market Situation \*

Lumber

In response to record levels of construction and industrial activity in 1955, lumber production during the first half of the year was considerably above the level attained during the first half of 1954. This situation reflects the active demand for stumpage in New Hampshire during the last part of 1955 and the early months of 1956.

During 1956 it has been assumed that the level of construction and industrial output will increase slightly over the level attained in 1955. However, residential construction, the most important end-use for lumber, is expected to decrease. Lumber consumption in 1956 may therefore fall slightly below levels attained during 1955.

Between 15 and 20 percent of all the lumber consumed in the United States is used for shipment of agricultural and industrial commodities. Thus the quantity of lumber used in shipping is closely identified with the level of economic activity. This is important in New Hampshire where so much of the white pine cut is of box board quality.

The demand for hardwood lumber for furniture and in building has been active during 1955 and 1956.

Between January and September, 1955, the wholesale price index of lumber increased from 120.0 to 127.1. This level is slightly above the previous all-time peak of 126.7 reached in March, 1951. Little change in lumber prices is expected in 1956. This situation reflects increased prices being paid for stumpage in 1956.

It is expected that by 1957 potential demand for lumber in the United States may amount to at least 46 billion feet - 12 percent above the level of consumption in 1955. This estimated increase in potential demand for lumber is based on an estimated decrease per capita use of lumber adjusted to expected increases in population.

#### Pulpwood

During the first half of 1955 national pulpwood consumption was 15 percent above the corresponding period in 1954 as a result of an exceptionally high level of demand for paper and board. It is estimated that total consumtion during 1955 amounted to about 33 million cords, or 13 percent higher than consumption in 1954, and 95 percent higher than consumption in 1945. This estimate of pulpwood consumption does not include the equivalent of an estimated 10 million cords of pulpwood imported in 1955 in the form of woodpulp, paper, and board.

In 1956 some further increase is expected in pulpwood consumption in response to increased demands for paper and board resulting from further increases in population and the assumed rise in gross national production and the continuing development of new uses for paper and paper products.

The new peak in pulpwood consumption in 1955 marks a continuation of a period of extremely rapid growth in the pulp and paper industry. Since 1946 the industry has expanded rapidly through construction of new mills and addition to or modernization of existing mills. Expansion has been particularly rapid in the south where more than half of the woodpulp industry is now located.

Pulpwood prices have shown little change since 1951. During 1956 no significant change in the price of pulpwood is anticipated. Prices paid for pulpwood in New Hampshire have advanced slightly during 1956 as compared with prices paid in 1955.

By 1975 it is estimated that the total national demand for pulpwood will amount to at least 56 million cords, or 30 percent more than current use. It is expected that about 2 million cords may be imported in the form of woodpulp and the equivalent of about 12 million cords in the form of woodpulp and paper. Thus demand on domestic forests in 1975 may amount to at least 42 million cords, or 40 percent above current production. Sufficient supplies of domestic pulpwood are expected to be available to meet this level of domestic demand without substantial increases in pulpwood prices. The pulp industry is increasing its use of mill waste as efficient ways are found to separate the bark from the wood.

#### Veneer Logs and Bolts

National consumption of hardwood veneer logs since 1951 has amounted to about 1 billion board feet per year, a level of consumption that is expected to be maintained during 1956. Consumption of softwood veneer logs, practically all of which is concentrated on the West Coast, has increased from 1.2 billion feet in 1951 to an estimated 2.0 billion board feet in 1955. Most of this increase is attributed to the expanding use of softwood plywood in construction.

Looking further ahead, substantial increases are expected in the demand for both softwood and hardwood veneer logs. By 1975 the potential demand for softwood veneer logs may amount to 2.7 billion board feet and hardwood veneer logs to 1.8 billion board feet. A potential demand of 4.5 billion board feet would represent an increase of 50 percent over the 1955 level of consumption. Logs used for veneer, based on present standards of quality, are limited to old growth hardwood trees still standing on the large holdings in northern New Hampshire and a very few stands of second growth hardwood that may be found on small holdings in northern and central New Hampshire.

The demand for boltwood appears to remain at about the same level in 1956 as during 1955. There has been little change in prices paid for boltwood. White birch remains as the desired species and it becomes more and more difficult to locate good white birch.

#### Other Timber Products

Consumption of fuelwood in the United States continues to decline as a result of shifts to other fuels. In 1955 fuelwood cut from round wood, excluding plant residues used as fuel, amounted to about 25 million cords. By 1975 the demand for fuelwood is expected to be considerably lower than that now prevailing.

Consumption of miscellaneous industrial wood products such as poles and piling and posts, and a variety of other minor timber products in 1956 is expected to remain near the current level of about 700 million cubic feet a year. There is a good market in southern New Hampshire for piling, poles, and posts. Norway pine is the desired tree for these uses and pitchpine are bought for posts.

The demand for hardwood for cooperage, bolts, and wood pulp has been active during the later months of 1955 and the first few months of 1956.

# Recommendations for Selling

The New Hampshire woodland owners who plan to sell stumpage, logs, pulpwood, and other forest products are urged to consider the following recommendations before selling:

- 1. Find out from tuyers of stumpage, logs, pulpwood, and other forest products, the prices they offer in order that you may take advantage of the test market. Compare the local prices with those quoted from other sections of the State.
- 2. Before selling, consult your neighbors who have recently sold timber and use their experience as a guide. Ask your County Forester. In many instances, failure to do this has resulted in the woodland owner not getting full value of the product.
- 3. Thoroughly investigate all local timber requirements and prices, since, in many cases, local markets pay better prices than outside markets because of the saving of transportation charges.
- 4. Advertise and secure competition among outside purchasers. The expense will be small and outside buyers will thus learn of chances to bid on timber in competition with local buyers.
- 5. Secure bids whenever possible, both by the lump and by log scale measure. A choice is thus offered, and a more profitable form of bid can be accepted.
- 6. Consider the responsibility of the prospective purchaser before making the sale in order to avoid slow payment, costly collections, and losses.
- 7. When there is quality timber to market, these trees are worth more than the average or poor-quality tree. Be sure the buyer takes the factor of tree quality into consideration when offering you a price for stumpage.
- 8. Remember that standing timber usually increases in value. The owner, therefore, is not obliged to place his product on the market, if the price offered is not satisfactory. Sell only trees that should be cut. These trees should be marked by the owner or his agent with the help and advice of a qualified forester. Reliable operators will make partial cutting by taking only the marked trees, if the owner insists.
- 9. A written timber sale agreement between buyer and seller is important before cutting starts on a lot. Sample sale agreement forms to fit different kinds of operations can be obtained from your County Forester.

# Assistance Rendered by the County Forester

The County Forester helps woodland owners to help themselves. Your County Forester will assist you in the examination of your woodlands and make recommendations for managing them. He will help you or your agent in marking trees for cutting, and advise you in the marketing of forest products.

There are thousands of acres of young growing trees, such as pine, spruce, fir, and desirable hardwood, that can be converted into desirable stands of trees, if the overtopping weed trees are cut or killed. It is profitable to prune young, fast-growing, well-formed white pine with the purpose of growing quality logs that will yield clear lumber. Your County Forester can assist you in getting a forest improvement program started in the young stands on your woodlands.

# Range of Frices Paid for Forest Products, January 1956

Quality, quantity, location, logging chance, demand, and other factors affect the prices paid for stumpage, logs, pulpwood, piling, poles, fuelwood, and other forest products. The range in prices paid for hardwood stumpage and for readside and mill deliveries is so varied that the prices quoted show an extremely wide range. The quality of hardwood varies greatly from generally poor quality in southern New Hampshire to a variation of poor and good quality in northern New Hampshire.

Formula for determining cords of fuelwood, pulpwood and boltwood.

Average height in inches x length of pile in feet = number of cords **-**384

Example

$$\frac{48" \times 8!}{384} = 1 \text{ cord}$$

If wood is longer or shorter than standard length (48") divide standard bolt length to get correct percentage. (Example: 39" divided by 48" equals 81%)
